1 Enigmail

For this part of the focus group, you will send and receive encrypted emails using Enigmail. Enigmail requires you to have a "key" for yourself, and a key for each person you wish to send mail to.

Enigmail has already been installed on your machine. Follow the steps below.

1. Open Thunderbird to view your emails.

To get started, click on the Thunderbird icon in the menu bar at the left-hand side of your screen.



2. Generate your keys.

To get started, click on the OpenPGP tab at the top of your Thunderbird window. Select Setup Wizard from the drop-down menu. Follow the instructions given in the wizard.



3. Send your key to Study Coordinator.

To get started, compose a new email. When the compose window is open, click on the Open PGP tab at the top of your Thunderbird window. Select Attach My Public Key from the drop down window.



- 4. Read the encrypted email from Study Coordinator.
- 5. Import the Study Coordinator's key.

To import keys, click on the OpenPGP tab at the top of your Thunderbird window. Select Key Management from the drop-down menu.



6. Send the secret phrase in an encrypted email to the Study Coordinator.

2 Mailvelope

For this part of the focus group, you will send and receive encrypted emails using Mailvelope. Mailvelope requires you to have a "key" for yourself, and a key for each person you wish to send mail to.

Mailvelope has already been installed on your machine. Follow the steps below.

1. Sign into the gmail account specifically created for this study.
